Restoration of Stowey Quarry by landfilling of Stable Non Reactive Hazardous Waste (SNRHW) including asbestos and inert wastes and that the application is accompanied by an environmental statement.

Thank you for your letter of the 22 March. This Parish Council objects to the proposal for the following reasons:

Risk of contamination of water courses; limited ongoing monitoring; we do not believe there is a regional requirement for the proposed volume of this type of waste; this quarry was not identified in the Regional Waste Core Strategy for any type of landfill especially not for hazardous waste; strong local objections to the proposal; concerns on the effect such a facility will have on tourism in the area due to fears of asbestos exposure.
