HYDRAULIC FRACTURING TESTS IN MENDIP HILLS AONB

Following recent press reports and a report on Shale Gas Fracturing by Preece Hall, that this process has caused two minor earthquakes in Lancashire, concerns were raised that any future fracturing testing in the Mendip Hills could also cause such earthquakes and this could have a detrimental effect on any storage cells at Stowey Quarry, should permission for the landfilling of asbestos be granted. It was decided to advise B&NES of the council's concerns on this matter.
