**Re Planning Application for 112 houses planning reference 10/04015/OUT Land at Cautletts Close Midsomer Norton**

I note that you have been copied into a significant number of objections from local residents in connection with the above. I am writing to ensure that you are clear that notwithstanding the amount of objections that have been submitted (around 100) the application as it stands will be dealt with by officers and would not be reported to committee. This is fully in accordance with our scheme of delegation.

If this is not what you wish to happen and you would like to have this application heard at the committee you should make a request to that effect and provide your reasons why. Again this accords with our scheme of delegation.
