We have received your letter dated 29 May informing us that you have received revised plans/information for the above application. However, this gives a 21 day deadline for us to make any responses. We shall therefore be unable to comment within the 21 day deadline and would be grateful if you would delay your decision until you have received our comments after our meeting on the 4 July. Given that this application must already be well out of the target set for decision, we would have appreciated a longer deadline to enable us to consider the revised papers.
